### A Celebration of Awards at Ringwood & Fordingbridge 54<sup>th</sup> Charter Anniversary Dinner

**Ringwood & Fordingbridge Lions Club** was chartered in 1970 and celebrated their Anniversary at the St Leonards Hotel in Ringwood on Saturday 25 May 2024. The President of the Club, Lion Stephen Sherring, and District Governor-Elect Lion Sandra Manktelow presented the following awards that night to:-

#### **A Melvin Jones Fellowship Humanitarian Services Award to New Forest For Ukraine CEO, John Allison**

John Allison although retired, has displayed great commitment, leadership, and compassion by driving forward and expanding the idea and inspiration of two people from Brockenhurst who, in March 2022 simply wanted to help the people in Ukraine who were suffering.

They created New Forest For Ukraine (NFFU) and collected and donated aid and delivering to those most in need in Ukraine. They operated from a warehouse in Lymington. John was a volunteer at the time and stepped up in 2023 to take over running the operation to ensure their legacy continued. He has helped

to expand what they do and how they do it and orchestrated a regular articulated truck with pallets containing food, clothes, medical supplies, cooking utensils, portable gas cookers and generators to be dispatched every three weeks from Lymington to Ukraine and Poland for distribution. He has forged links with businesses, agencies and organisations nationally and internationally and devoted a great deal of his own time and energy to make sure NFFU is a success. Club President Lion Stephen Sherring said: *"John is an inspiration for what he has done at New Forest For Ukraine over the past 18 months and fully deserves to be a Melvin Jones Fellow"*.
